Well Life Community Gardener



The transition from Summer into Autumn, with changing light and weather conditions can tempt us into spending less time outdoors, but actually Autumn is a wonderful time to spend in the garden; with glorious colours, crunchy leaves, cooler temperatures and an opportunity to top up your vitamin D. The allotment is still producing fruit and veg and the soil in your garden is warm enough to plant Spring bulbs - crocus, daffodils and tulips being the most popular.

There is still so much that can be achieved in the garden in Autumn and getting outside is so important, even if it is for just 20 minutes per day to clear your mind and get some fresh air.

Winter in the garden 🧨

Winter may bring less daylight hours and colder temperatures, but this is all the more reason to make the most of those crisp, clear days when we can get outside, albeit at a gentler pace. The time when your garden is resting and recharging for Spring is a great time to do mindful jobs in the outdoors, such as pruning or sowing seeds in the greenhouse. Sowing Sweet Peas is a great investment of your time with rewarding results the following Summer.

Planting Winter flowering containers is a great activity to bring some much needed colour to our gardens. Great Winter plant choices are cyclamen, pansies and Winter heather.

Spring into Action

Spring is the season when your garden starts to wake up and put on growth daily. It's lovely to take a slow, deliberate walk around your garden on a bright sunny morning, or on your travels during the day to take notice of the Spring bulbs starting to emerge and new shoots popping up everywhere. With it, Spring brings hope for the busy growing season ahead. It's a good time to start to plan all of the lovely fruit, veg and flowers that you can grow to make your outdoor space, however big or small, whatever you want it to be.

Gardening is hugely beneficial for your physical and mental wellbeing, whether it be planting in pots, tending to an allotment plot or working in your outside garden space.


